Background: The Web-based Cancer Program Practice Profile Reports (CP³R) offer local providers comparative information to assess adherence to and consideration of standard of care therapies for major cancers. This reporting tool provides a platform from which to promote continuous practice improvement to improve quality of patient care at the local level and also permits hospitals to compare their care for these patients relative to that of other providers.

B R E A S T	Radiation therapy is administered within 1 year (365 days) of diagnosis for women under age 70 receiving breast conserving surgery for breast cancer. (Accountability)	98.6%	95.3%	89.9%	
	Combination chemotherapy is considered or administered within 4 months (120 days) of diagnosis for women under 70 with AJCC T1c N0 M0, or Stage II or III ERA and PRA negative breast cancer. (Accountability)	100%	94.4%	90.5%	
	Tamoxifen or third generation aromatase inhibitor is considered or administered within 1 year (365 days) of diagnosis for women with AJCC T1c N0 M0, or Stage II or III ERA and/or PRA positive breast cancer. (Accountability)	91.9%	92.8%	89.4%	
C O L O N	Adjuvant chemotherapy is considered or administered within 4 months (120 days) of diagnosis for patients under the age of 80 with AJCC Stage III (lymph node positive) colon cancer. (Accountability)	100%	94.8%	89.8%	
	At least 12 regional lymph nodes are removed and pathologically examined for resected colon cancer. (Quality Improvement)	75.9%	84.4%	88%	
R E C T U M	Radiation therapy is considered or administered within 6 months (180 days) of diagnosis for patients under the age of 80 with clinical or pathologic AJCC T4N0M0 or stage III receiving surgical resection for rectal cancer (Surveillance)	100%	93.8%	88.8%
